Curriculum Guide

This guide breaks down our quarters and gives a little glimpse of what students will learn each month. Each month has a main theme; this theme will be the same every year. Each week has a sub themes; these may change or may be in a different order each year to keep the topics fun! We also use Frog Street and Answers in Gensis to support our curriculum and provide more fun learning! Our curriculum is inclusive; this means it is for our infants-preschool students. We start our infants off with the basics (visuals) to get them familiar with the topics, we then dive deeper as they get older.

When our student's become preschoolers, we do a quarterly assessment. The assessments help the teachers understand what areas may need to be focused on more and helps the parents learn how to help at home. We use these assessments at parent/teacher meetings and we keep them in their portfolios. Each student (infant-preschool) gets a portfolio where we keep all of the amazing things they do throughout the year! We can use them to track progress, as a tool at parent/teacher meetings and as a keepsake at the end of each curriculum year (August-July).

Under each quarter you will also see potential field trips and meet the teacher events. These are just a general idea list, some years we may do more, some years we may do less. Field trips and meet the teacher events are strictly circumstantial. We try to keep these related to our themes however we will also take neighborhood walks, go to the park (sometimes we may take a picnic), and go to the library throughout the year when the weather permits. We may also add in a few "just for fun" places as well!
